Carnegie High School a College Preparatory High School has partnered with West Valley Christian School and is located in West Hills, California. Carnegie education emphasizes the highest level of academic achievement utilizing a traditional classroom experience using a blended learning environment led by highly qualified teachers, using the most advanced, web-based curriculum incorporating the latest in technology advances available. Students attend class five days a week and all curriculums are accessed and student work performed on a laptop/ tablet provided by Carnegie under the direction of qualified teachers. Blended learning is very unique because it allows students to study at their own personal pace and allows more time for subjects that might be a little more difficult. In addition to the traditional classroom teacher, students have access to a network of live, online, tutors through the curriculum portal. These online tutors and full technical support are available to students 24 hours 5 days a week allowing students to continue their studies at home. Carnegie certified teachers are ready to assist students with their academic and technology needs on campus or off campus. Carnegie High School curriculum is fully accredited through the North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School improvement (NCA CASI), through the Northwest Accreditation Commission (NWAC), and is NCAA approved.
