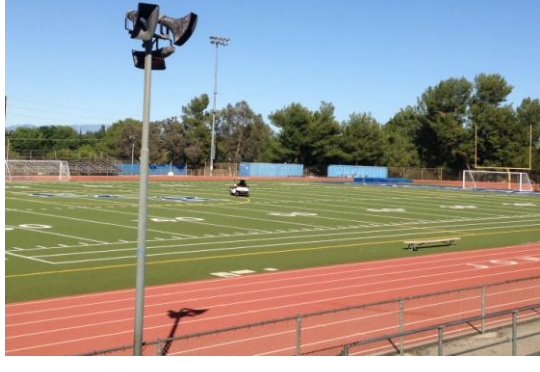

Accomplishments: **El Camino Real Charter is one of the most successful teams in the history of Academic Decathlon**, and arguably the single most successful team of the last decade. **ECR has a record 6 National Championships, the most of any high school in the Nation. El Camino's sports teams are one of the highest rankings competing in the CIF Championship Playoffs.** El Camino's Science Bowl competes in one of the most difficult regions in all of the United States. In recent years, they have made it to the semifinals and placed in the top 4 four times in recent history. *The King's Courier* is El Camino's award-winning school newspaper. Members of its staff return every year with trophies from regional, state and national competition, and its editors have moved on to positions on newspapers at schools such as Harvard, Ithaca, Cornell, UCLA and Columbia. **JETS** (Junior Engineering Technical Society) promotes interest in engineering, science, math, and technology in high school students and provides them with real-world engineering teamwork and problem-solving experiences. ECR Robotics won the US National Championship again and became the first high school to win three national titles.
