Located in Los Angeles, Ribét campus features a landmark 6 story main building that houses and has Southern California's largest marine biology lab that has 7 saltwater aquariums. Other specialized learning environments include orchestra and dance studios, a courtroom, a 99 seat theater, 2 art studios, and a photography studio. Ribét Academy encourages students to challenge themselves by taking Honors and Advanced Placement courses during High School. Average SAT score is 1200. Ribet offers a comprehensive and rigorous Visual Arts curriculum. All Art faculty members are professional artists. Unique to Ribet is the art department collaboration with area museums. The Arts Department has worked with: The Museum of Tolerance, The California African American Museum, The Chinese American Museum and The Japanese American Museum. Ribet's Visual Art Program is well known with approximately 10% of the graduating class moving on to study Fine Art at the University level.
