Saint Anthony's High School is a co-educational Catholic high school located in South Huntington, New York and is only an hour train ride to New York City. Saint Anthony's has constructed a brand new Science Center which includes 5 Advanced Science Laboratories which include: Chemistry and Microbiology Lab, Physics and Earth Environmental Science Lab, Anatomy and Forensics Lab and Biology and Marine Biology Lab. In addition, the center provides 9 Science classes, 3 Science Prep Rooms, and 1 research room for Saint Anthony's Nationally recognized Friarquest Research Program. In addition to academic classes, Honors and AP classes, College credit courses are offered through St. Anthony's affiliate at Long Island University (13 classes). Saint Anthony's has a student population of 2,400 and a 12% percent international student population.
